## Our Objectives

**The goal of all new cars, trucks and buses to be zero polluting by 2035 is achievable:** Every major truck, bus and car manufacturer is already developing or investing in all-electric, zero-emission vehicles.

## New York Clean Economy Snapshot

**More than 153,000 New Yorkers** already work in clean energy jobs (3rd in the country).

**Nearly 7,000 New York workers** manufacture or service zero emissions trucks and buses, 19th among all states.

Electric vehicles already account for **8,977 NY jobs**, and there are **32,590 EVs** on the roads in New York.

Congress is considering clean energy investments that would provide **\$13.3 billion** in funding for energy efficiency in **New York and create more than 144,000 jobs** over five years, contributing \$13.5 billion to the state's GDP.

**12 separate New York companies** are part of the national manufacturing and servicing supply chain for zero emissions trucks and buses, the 13th highest in the nation.

Renewable energy would also **save the average New York household \$500 a year** -- totaling more than **\$64.3 million cut from New York electric bills** by 2030.
